

Terms & Conditions

In these Terms & Conditions the following definitions are: Organiser refers to Great Northern Events (NW) Ltd. Exhibitors refers to any persons selected to participate at The Great Northern Contemporary Craft Fair at Spinningfields 2010

1. Exhibitors must keep their stands open and attended by knowledgeable staff throughout the period of the event and wherever possible this should be the designer-maker.
2. Exhibitors may not sub-let space within the area allocated to them.
3. The organiser reserves the right to move stands and relocate space previously notified to exhibitors and to cancel and/or amend the event if required by circumstances outside their control.
4. Exhibitors must not display goods of an inflammable, noxious or obscene nature. Fabrics used on stands for display purposes must be fireproofed. The organiser will remove any such unsuitable material from the event.
5. Exhibitors will be liable for any damage caused to the panels, flooring or stand fittings.
6. Exhibitors will be liable for any damage they cause to the event building/structure.
7. Exhibitors may not move or install any lighting or electrical appliances without the written approval of the organiser. Any lighting or electrical appliance not supplied by the electrical contractor must be approved and PAT tested by the contractor.
8. The organiser accepts no liability for the loss or damage to exhibitors' work, neither during the event, nor during setting-up or dismantling. Insurance is the responsibility of the individual exhibitor and the exhibitors must insure they are covered for all eventualities (including public liability insurance).
9. Payment in full must be received at least 20 days prior to the opening of the event. The organiser reserves the right to refuse admission to exhibitors who have not paid for their stand in full prior to the event opening.
10. All first instalments/ deposits for stands must be received by the Organiser by the 11th of June 2010. Second payments (50% of the balance outstanding) must be received by the 30th of July 2010 and final payments (remainder of the balance outstanding) must be received by the 17th of September 2010. Exhibitors' deposits are non-refundable.
11. Exhibitors withdrawing from the event after accepting space are liable to pay 50% of their stand fees. Exhibitors who cancel within 20 days of the start of the fair (1st October 2010) are liable for the total cost of the stand.
12. The organiser reserves the right to withdraw their offer of space from any exhibitors owing monies to the organiser on any account.
13. All exhibitors should give full cooperation to the organisers and/or appointed publicity contractor in attempting to achieve coverage and promotion for the event.
14. The organiser cannot accept responsibility for any issues arising as a result of problems with the venue or its staff. If, because of war, fire, strike, or other cause beyond the control of the organisers, the event is cancelled, exhibitors remain liable for stand fees as per clause 11, and the organisers shall have no liability to exhibitors from the loss of income resulting from such cancellation.
15. If the organiser cancels the event, exhibitors' deposits and stand fees will be reimbursed in full but the organiser can not be held liable for any additional expenses incurred.
16. Any agreements entered into by the exhibitor and an external contractor or supplier at the event, are the responsibility of the exhibitor and the organiser can not accept liability for claims resulting from the failure of any of its contractors or suppliers to deliver goods or services.
17. Whilst the organiser takes every effort to ensure that exhibitors contact details are correct in the promotional material for the event, the organiser cannot accept responsibility for any errors printed therein and the organiser shall have no liability to exhibitors for any claims resulting from such errors.
18. In consideration of the organisers assisting exhibitors in promoting their work, exhibitors must agree to grant the organisers a non exclusive copyright licence for any promotional materials supplied to the organiser and/or its appointed publicity contractor, for the purpose of promoting and publicising their work and the event. In granting this licence exhibitors should be aware that the promotions may include the use of these materials on the internet and that images supplied may be scanned and held digitally for this purpose. The copyright is and will continue to be beneficially and solely owned by the exhibitor, who must ensure that it does not and will not infringe on any other copyright and that no information contained in the materials is or shall be inaccurate, misleading or injurious.
